RainGain is a new Interreg NWE IVB project on fine-scale rainfall estimation and forecasting in support of urban drainage flood modelling and nowcasting. X-band radar technology will be integrated with the national C-band radar data, rain gauge data and numerical weather prediction. Case-studies are the cities of Leuven, Rotterdam, Paris and London. Belgian partners are K.U.Leuven – Hydraulics Division and Aquafin.
